Please set your items on the curb. Items will be picked up the 19th and 20th. If you need help removing items from your home please contact the library to make arrangements.

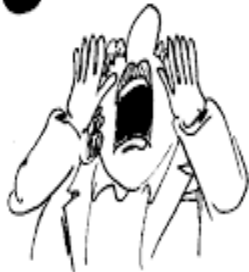
MILLSTONE/TIME CAPSULE UPDATE:

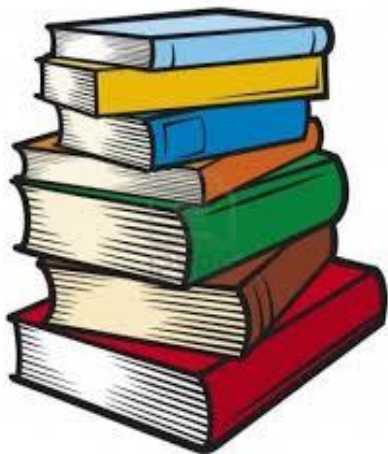
